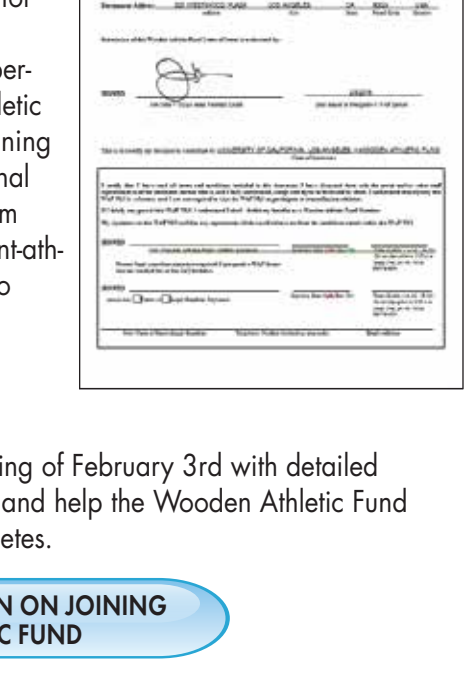

UCLA Football Select-a-Seat Priority

As an exclusive benefit of membership, all Wooden Athletic Fund members receive priority to improve their UCLA Football Season Tickets ahead of non-donor Season Ticket Holders and the general public through the UCLA Football Select-a-Seat process. Priority for seat improvement is based upon Wooden Athletic Fund membership level, lifetime giving to UCLA Athletics and years as a UCLA Football Season Ticket Purchaser.

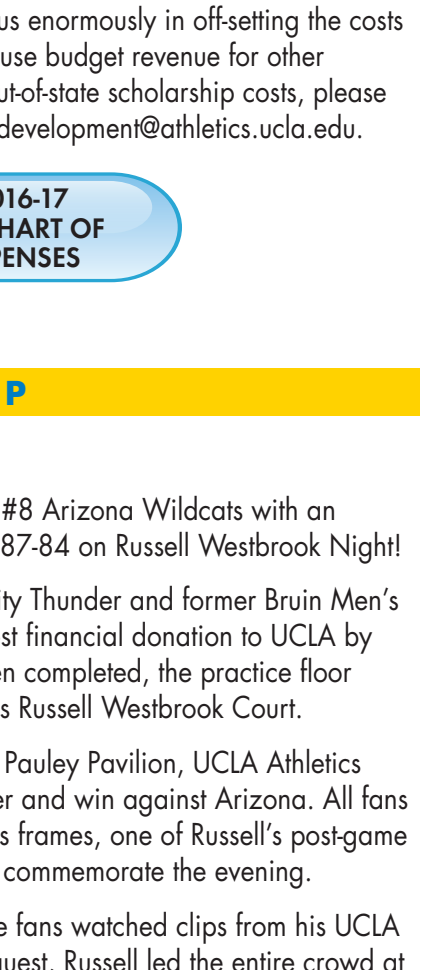

IN-STATE SCHOLARSHIP STUDENT-ATHLETE'S ANNUAL EXPENSES

Each year, scholarships expenses for student-athletes rise as the costs associated with their scholarships rise. The question often asked is: what goes into a student-athlete's scholarship cost that makes the annual cost go up so much?



For any in-state UCLA student, annual expenses for tuition, room, board, and books is approximately \$33,733. For an in-state UCLA student-athlete, however, obviously there are additional expenses. Expenses such as equipment, gear and uniforms (approximately \$4,538), sports medicine and training room (\$3,976), academic services which include advisors, tutors, mentors, etc. (\$3,519), team travel (\$12,585), athletic performance and weight training (\$4,008) and game expenses (\$7,473) come to a total of \$69,832 — more than double the expense of a non-student-athlete UCLA student.

The support received from our generous WAF donors helps us budgetarily in off-setting the costs of student-athlete scholarships, which allows our coaches to use budget revenue for other program needs. Russell Westbrook Night - January 7, 2016

On January 7, 2016, the Bruins beat perennial Pac-12 foe #8 Arizona Wildcats with an exciting, last-minute three-point shot by Bryce Alford to win 87-84 on Russell Westbrook Night!

In mid-December, current NBA All-Star for the Oklahoma City Thunder and former Bruin Men's Basketball student-athlete Russell Westbrook made the largest financial donation to UCLA by any former basketball student-athlete in school history. When completed, the practice floor inside the new Mo Ostin Basketball Center will be known as Russell Westbrook Court.

To recognize Russell's generosity and welcome him back to Pauley Pavilion, UCLA Athletics honored the NBA All-Star in the Bruins' Pac-12 home opener and win against Arizona. All fans in attendance were treated to complimentary black eyeglass frames, one of Russell's post-game NBA press conference trademarks, courtesy of Wescom, to commemorate the evening.

At halftime, Russell was honored in a brief ceremony, where fans watched clips from his UCLA playing days. The biggest treat came when, at his own request, Russell led the entire crowd at Pauley Pavilion in a great UCLA 8-Clap.

Russell also served as the game's Honorary Captain, and mingled with our Wooden Athletic Fund guests before the game at the Pavilion Club. Russell, his wife Nina [Earl] Westbrook, also a former UCLA basketball student-athlete, as well as his parents Russell and Shannon Westbrook, were seated courtside while Russell's Oklahoma City Thunder teammates sat nearby to watch the exciting Bruin win.

Bruins at the Beach

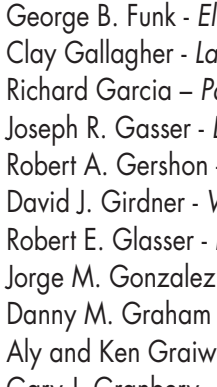

On October 22, 2015, the UCLA Football team debuted the All Black LA City uniforms in the battle for the state of California against rival Cal Berkeley. The LA City uniforms are the fourth dark alternate uniform that the team has worn in the past four years and for the second year in a row, a very limited number of the authentic helmets are available to UCLA fans to bid on.

UCLA ATHLETICS' COMPLIANCE CORNER

Prior Relationships

UCLA donors ("boosters") are prohibited from providing any type of benefit to a current or prospective student-athlete, unless the booster can prove that he/she maintains a clear pre-existing relationship with the athlete or their parents. According to NCAA rules, the following criterion must be proven in order for a relationship between a booster and an athlete (or the athlete's parents) to be considered pre-existing:

1. The relationship did not develop as a result of the athlete's athletics participation or athletics notoriety;
2. The relationship must have started before the athlete triggered prospect status (prior to entering 9th grade);
3. The relationship must predate any fame or notoriety gained by the athlete as a result of athletics achievements; and,
4. The pattern of benefits provided by the booster prior to the athlete becoming a recruited prospect is similar in nature to those provided after attaining such status.

The UCLA Athletics Compliance Office can help by reviewing relationships which might be considered "pre-existing" before any benefit can be provided by a UCLA booster. Please do not assume that any relationships you have with a recruit or current student-athlete or his/her families are permissible based on the above criteria, and we encourage you to contact the Compliance Office regarding these scenarios.
