

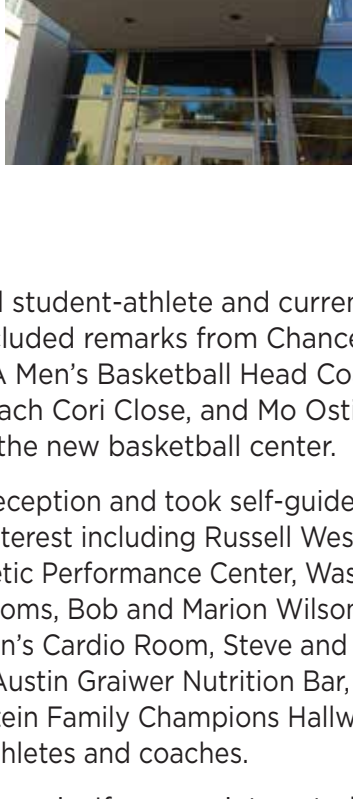
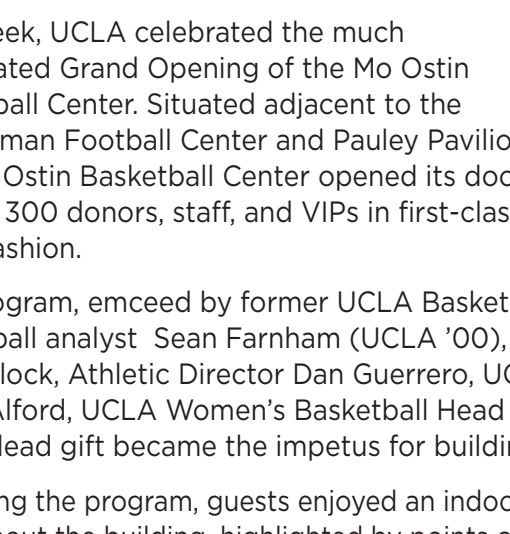

MO OSTIN BASKETBALL CENTER GRAND OPENING - OCTOBER 26, 2017

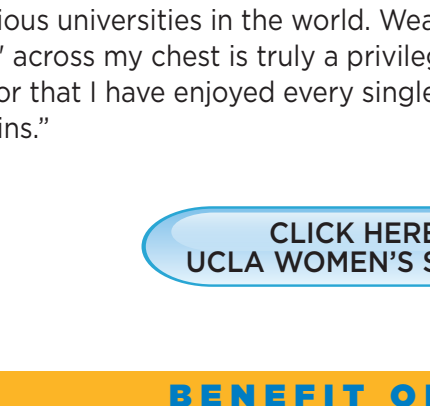
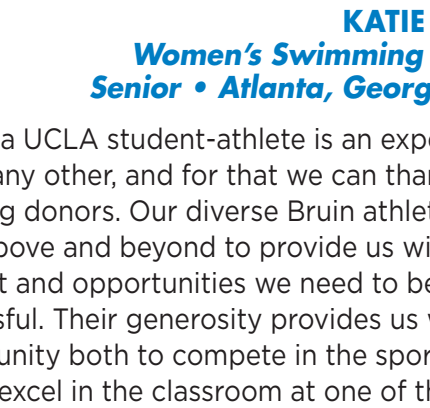


Last week, UCLA celebrated the much anticipated Grand Opening of the Mo Ostin Basketball Center. Situated adjacent to the Wasserman Football Center and Pauley Pavilion, the Mo Ostin Basketball Center opened its doors to over 300 donors, staff, and VIPs in first-class Bruin fashion.

The program, emceed by former UCLA Basketball student-athlete and current basketball analyst Sean Farnham (UCLA '00), included remarks from Chancellor Gene Block, Athletic Director Dan Guerrero, UCLA Men's Basketball Head Coach Steve Alford, UCLA Women's Basketball Head Coach Cori Close, and Mo Ostin, whose lead gift became the impetus for building the new basketball center.

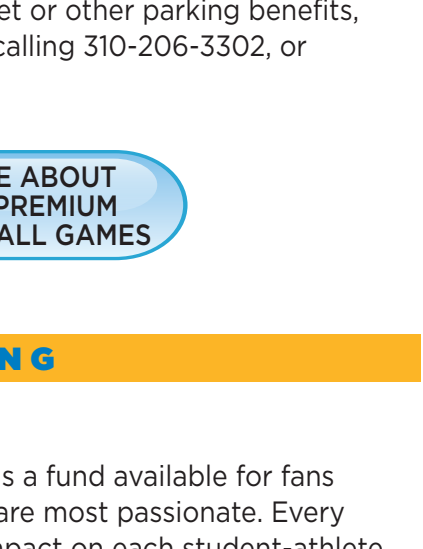

UCLA Basketball Parking

With men's and women's basketball seasons getting underway, it is important to know that all WAF members have the exclusive opportunity to request priority season parking. For men's basketball, exclusive WAF donor parking passes are offered for Lots 4, 7, and 8. Like all Wooden Athletic Fund benefits, this exclusive access is allocated first by WAF donor level, followed by lifetime giving to UCLA Athletics and consecutive years as a season ticket holder.

In addition, as part of the WAF Premium Experience, WAF members at the Director's Circle (\$25,000) level and above can arrive in style at Pauley Pavilion with priority entry and exit to and from our Exclusive Valet parking service in Lot 7.

Pauley Pavilion is also easily accessible from campus Lots 4, 7, and 8, for a flat rate of \$12 per car on game days.

Individual Sport Giving

Each of UCLA's 25 intercollegiate athletics teams has a fund available for fans to directly support the programs about which they are most passionate. Every sport-specific gift is important and has a positive impact on each student-athlete on that team. As a donor, the benefits offered for gifts made to a specific sport vary by sport and gift amount. However, donors who contribute \$25,000 or more to a single sport will also be recognized with non-seating Wooden Athletic Fund member benefits at the Director's Circle level, and donors who contribute \$50,000 or more to a single sport will be recognized with non-seating Wooden Athletic Fund member benefits at the John R. Wooden Benefactor level for that membership year. Wooden Athletic Fund benefits for priority season tickets are offered only for gifts directed specifically to the Wooden Athletic Fund.

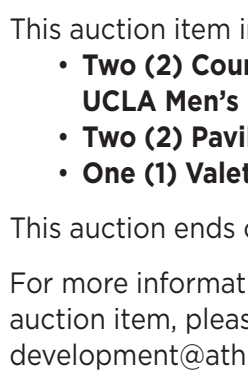

Cat person or dog person? Dog

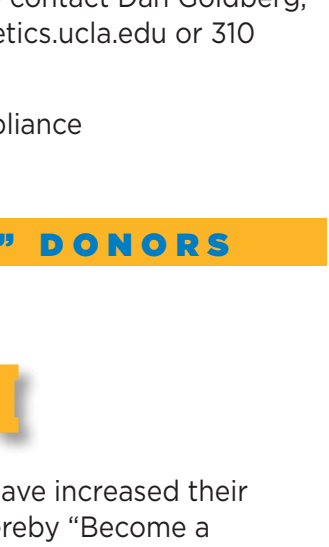
What was your high school mascot? Conquistadors

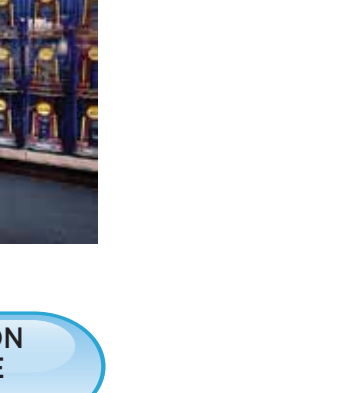
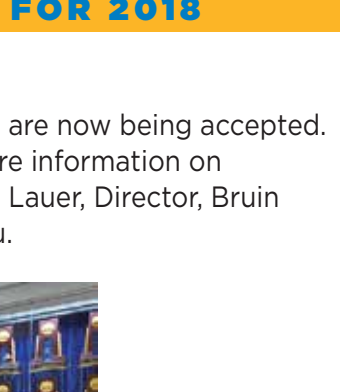
OCTOBER 10K CHAMPIONS EXPERIENCE WINNER

UCLA ATHLETICS' COMPLIANCE CORNER

RECRUITING RULES AND SOCIAL MEDIA GUIDELINES

The National Letter of Intent early signing period starts next Wednesday, November 8 for all UCLA sports except Football, Soccer and Men's Water Polo. The deadline for submissions is December 31, 2017. For more information on where prospective student-athletes ("prospects" or "recruits") will be signing. Please keep in mind that under NCAA rules, UCLA boosters are NOT permitted to use social networking websites such as Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, and Instagram to contact or otherwise communicate with prospects for the purpose of persuading them to attend UCLA. More specifically, UCLA boosters **may NOT** utilize social media for the following activities:

- Mentioning a prospect publicly on Facebook, Twitter or other social media site.
- Tweeting at or writing a wall post on a prospect's profile.
- Re-tweeting or re-posting a prospect where adding any comments to the post.
- Sending messages to a prospect through Facebook or Twitter chat or message functions even if a prospect asks for advice on what school to choose.
- Creating a fan group that is aimed at persuading a prospect to commit to UCLA.

Note that UCLA boosters **may** follow a prospect on Facebook or Twitter as long as they are not reaching out to that prospect in any way to encourage them to attend UCLA. Please know that schools have reported NCAA violations where boosters contacted potential recruits through social media websites and impermissibly encouraged them to attend their school. Although recruiting is a passionate subject for many fans, we ask that Bruins supporters exercise restraint and keep NCAA rules in mind when utilizing social networks.

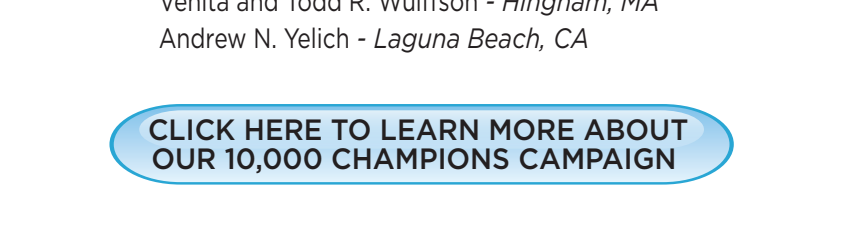
